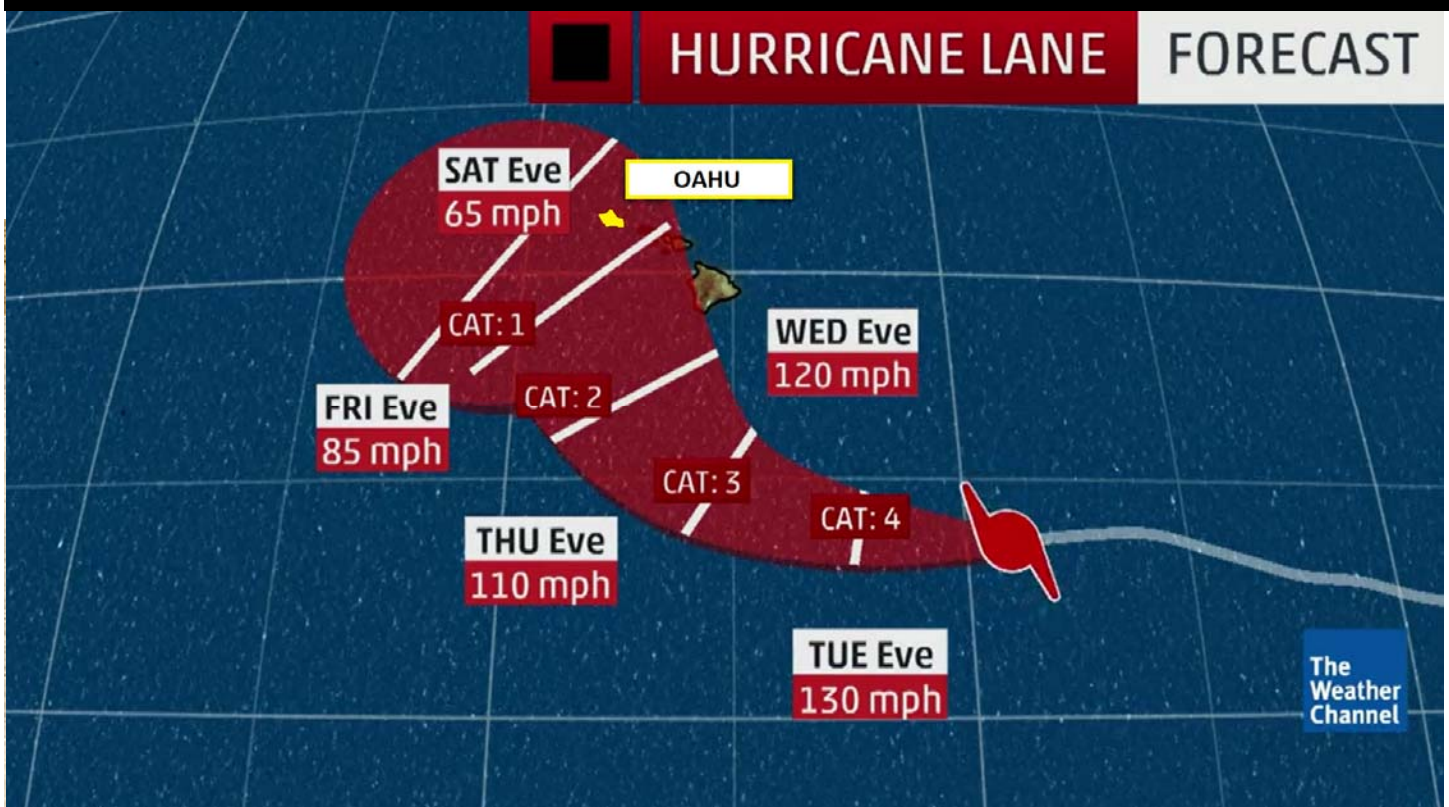


# IMPORTANT



The current forecast has Lane southwest of Honolulu as a weakening hurricane on Friday. As the impacts from a hurricane extend well away from the center, associated heavy rains and high winds are expected to impact the island. Furthermore, there is the possibility that Oahu will face a direct hit, so residents of 1350 Ala Moana need to be prepared.

## IMPORTANT REMINDERS

- Protect your property by closing windows and placing towels in areas where water may enter (i.e., beneath sliding doors, beneath windows, and around air conditioners).
- For those with an awning, raise and secure your awning.
- If you are parked in the lower garage, use your own discretion with regard to relocating your vehicle. *\*Staff cannot be responsible for finding alternate parking for residents.*
- Make sure your 14-day hurricane kit is fully stocked.
- If weather conditions become dangerous, the third floor recreation area will be closed.
- Should there be a power outage, the emergency generator will power the hallway lights on every floor, the lights in the parking garage, and one elevator (elevator #1).
